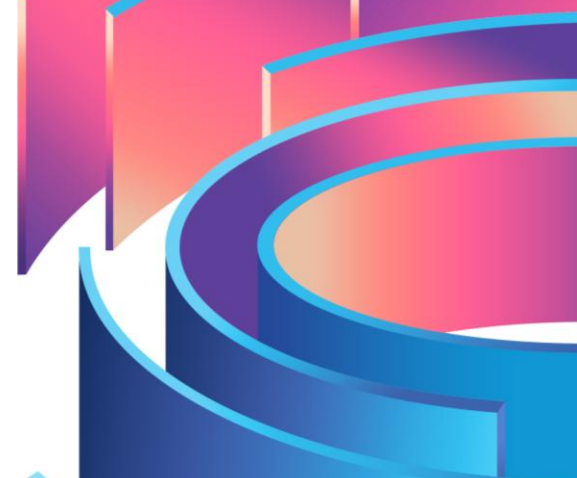

Abstract requirements:

**Presentation title**

Clearly indicate the industry and topic of your presentation.

**Abstract**

Provide a concise summary (100–250 words) outlining the key insights of your presentation.

**Presenter Details**

Include the name, biography, and a high-quality photo of each presenter.

**Speakers**

Specify the names of the speakers that commit to present at the conference (maximum of 2)

This year, we will feature two main conference tracks, making the selection process more rigorous due to a limited number of speaking slots. Be sure to submit a strong, insightful abstract for consideration!

After the submission deadline, the abstracts will undergo an objective peer review. We will inform you by June 2025 if your abstract has been selected.
